He is also a founding board member of the Sustainable Biodiesel Alliance and Shadowcliff, a Colorado-based environmental non-profit education facility in Grand County. Over the past seven years he has spoken nationally and internationally on issues related to rural development, sustainability and energy. Michael served as Chair of Colorado’s New Energy Future in 2006 and was co-chair of Governor-elect Bill Ritter’s transition team for energy policy. He currently serves as an Advisor to the Savory Institute and to the **DyneGroup** with fellow advisory board members **Governor Tom Ridge** and **General Wesley Clark**. Michael is a graduate of the Colorado Agriculture and Rural Leadership program was a Next Generation Fellow in Columbia University’s American Assembly and a 2008 recipient of Gamma Sigma Delta’s Significant Achievement in Agricultural Award by Colorado State University.
